

# What are thev?

Leaf shaped props that safely open saxophone key pads so the Eb, Low C# and G# air dry clean after you play. They slide under low Eb and C# key arms without touching pad leather. Because Low C# links with G#, all three of the stickiest pads are open to dry, preventing sticky pad rot.



# Sticky G#?

Leaving open Low C# also opens G# to air dry. Some early vintage horns don't work this way so we made the props detachable for use on these early vintage saxes! Check out KeyLeaves.com/Instructions

# Safe for pads?

Yes. It works without touching delicate pad leather and pads are most healthy when left open. For example, look at your low C pad or the pads under the pearls. These pads rarely stick because they are left open after you play - not rotting closed on the tone hole like low Eb.

#### Safe for the instrument finish?

Yes. Silver, copper, bronze, lacquer, wood & more.

#### Does it bend keys or weaken springs?

No. The squishy silicone flexes and bends so keys don't. It's safe enough for beginning band. Sax springs are designed to stay springy for decades. Intense field testing and endorsements from world-class pros prove that Key Leaves products are safe.

#### What about swabbing?

We love swabbing so much it is step one in our instructions. But we know kids struggle to learn sax hygiene, so we field tested this product without cleaning for a year (yuck). Using Key Leaves props reduced sticky key malfunction by 98% even without swabbing!
